Through her journey from academia to establishing a name in the market, she managed to encourage young mind to innovate, think out of the box and step out if their comfort zones.

He has written about 80 papers and has proved to be a remarkable figure that changed the industrial production of many products. He also has many patents in his name. He started by explaining the importance of vinegar in Indian household. However, the method used was crude and very slow. This led to commercial production of synthetic vinegar which lacked nutrition value.

He worked hard and along with his team, managed to develop a dual fermentation technology and get it patented. He provided insight into commercialization of products and bridged the gap between theory and application of scientific work.

Both experts interacted with audience showing zeal and answered their queries.
